Education Law, Section 6305, provides the Chief Fiscal Officer of each county, as defined in Section 2.00 of the Local Finance Law, shall, upon application and submission to him of satisfactory evidence, issue to any person desiring to enroll in a community college as a non-resident student, a certificate of residence showing that said person is a resident of said county...Such person shall, upon registration for each college year, file with the college such a certificate of residence ISSUED NOT EARLIER THAN TWO MONTHS PRIOR THERETO, and such certificate of residence shall be valid for one year from the date of issuance.

Education law, Section 6301, paragraph 4, defines: Resident - A person who has resided in the state for a period of at least one year and in the county, city, town, intermediate school district or school district, as the case may be, for a period of at least six months, both immediately preceding the date of such person's registration in a community college, or for the purpose of Section Sixty-Three Hundred Five of this chapter, such person's, application for a certificate of residence.

* * In the event that a person qualified as above for state residence but has been a resident of two or more counties in the state during the six months immediately preceding such person's application for a certificate of residence pursuant to Section Sixty-Three Hundred Five of this chapter, the charges to the counties of residence shall be allotted among the several counties proportional to the number of months, or major fraction, or residence in each county.
