<sup>\*</sup>Education Law, Section 6305, provides: "The Chief Fiscal Officer of each county, as defined in section 2.00 of the local finance law, shall, upon application and submission to him/her of satisfactory evidence, issue to any person desiring to enroll in a community college as a non-resident student, a certificate of residence showing the said person is a resident of said county. Such person shall, upon his/her registration for each college year, file with the college such a certificate of residence issued not earlier than two months prior thereto, and such certificate of residence shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of issuance." Education Law, Section 6301, paragraph 4, defines: "Resident." A person who has resided in the state for a period of at least one year and in the county, city, town, intermediate school district or school district, as the case may be, for a period of at least six months, both immediately preceding the date of such person's registration in a community college or, for the purposes of section sixty-three hundred five of this chapter, his/her application for a certificate of residence. \*\* In the event that a person qualified as above for state residence, but has been a resident of two or more counties in the state during the six months immediately preceding his/her application for a certificate of residence shall be allocated among the several counties proportional to the number of months, or major fraction thereof, of residence in each county.
